# 3. Detailed Areas

### **Health & Wellbeing**

Several meetings were held along with meetings with the Senior Management Team to discuss this area to try and help the school be the best it can be at providing the best environment for all children on the role of Linlithgow Academy.

### **Accommodation & Capacity**

# Coronavirus response

This involved providing input on the various challenges that the school was facing during this time and also providing feedback to the senior management team about the provision of the ongoing education of our children and the pastoral support that they needed.

### 4. Formal meetings

The Parent Forum consists of all parents/guardians of children at Linlithgow Academy who automatically become members on the entry of their child to the school.
