*Assembly Hall

1. Altra- Using Past Papers effectively

Miss Dickson, Humanities PTC will showcase the past paper builder resource known as **Altra** and discuss how using past papers to create model answers and self-assess can be a helpful revision tool

2. Scholar and Achieve
