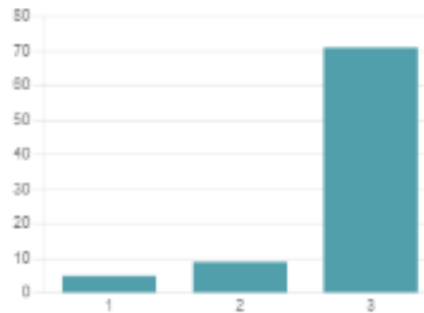


3. How easy did you find the booking system in advance of this evening (1-struggled, 3- smooth)

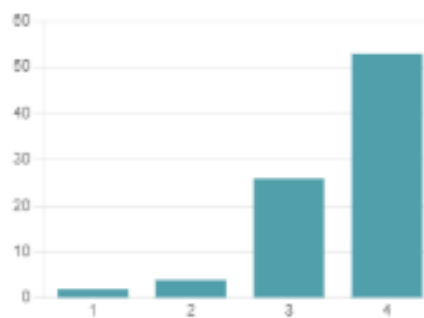


4. On the evening did you manage to connect to all of your child's teachers that you were booked in to see? (1- none, 2-a few, 3-most, 4- all)

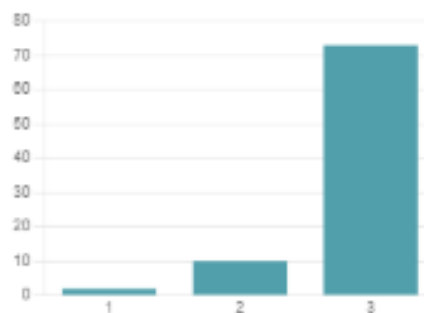

### Summarised Positives from the evening

The feedback was very positive, with parents expressing appreciation for the ease of access and efficiency of the online format. They found it easy to navigate, with clear timings and no waiting times. Many parents also appreciated being able to speak to more teachers than they would have done in person. Teachers were well prepared and provided meaningful feedback, and many parents found the process slick and well-structured. Nearly all parents preferred the online format, finding it more flexible and convenient.

### Summarised Frustrations from the evening

Some parents reported issues with the technology, such as poor connections, glitching, and not being able to join or move appointments. Some expressed frustration with the short five-minute appointment slots and difficulties with engaging in conversation online. A few parents felt that a face-to-face meeting would be more beneficial, especially during critical times in their child's education, such as course choices and exam years. Nearly all appreciated the convenience and flexibility of online parents' evenings. Some parents requested more time with teachers, longer appointment slots, or an opportunity to view their child's work in person.
