Identified key strengths to build on....

The following aspects of school life have been commented on as positives from parents/carers (who responded) which we will continue to consolidate and improve on..

Areas of further development...

The following aspects of school life have been identified as areas we need to investigate further/ consider as school improvement priorities for next session

most parents believe their child enjoys school (80%)

most parents believe staff treat your child with respect (86%)

most believe your child is safe at school (80%)

most believe school uniform is important (76%)

most believe the school is well led (80%)

most wish parents evenings to remain online (75%)

most are overall satisfied with the school (77%)

50% of parents have not experienced bullying issues. Remaining 30 % agree the school deals well with bullying/20% disagree/don't know.

a few, (11%) disagree their child is safe, 10% don't know

majority believe my child receives the help they need to do well. 23% disagree

majority believe the school supports my child's emotional wellbeing. 19% disagree

majority believes the info I receive reaches me at right time. 29% disagree

majority of parents understand how my child is assessed. 24% disagree

less than half (38%) believe the school gives advice on how to support my child's learning at home.
