#### **BYOD Pupil Summary Key Points**



Connect your digital devices to the internet using the AAL network



Follow the school's Pupil Acceptable Use of ICT Policy (same as the policy for smartphones)



It's at each teacher's discretion as to when digital devices may be used in class





Devices are used for educational purposes only during the school day

#### **BYOD Pupil Summary**



The school reserve to right to monitor content usage



Devices should not be used to record audio or take photographs/videos of other pupils or staff within their permission



Device must be adequately charged before brining to to school
